Dear Elementary Parents and Guardians,

With the second semester approaching, families will have the opportunity to change their student's enrollment. Second semester options are different due to required teacher staffing. **Your student will automatically be enrolled in the traditional in-person learning path unless you opt-out at www.putnamcityschools.org/s2 by Friday November 20th, 2020.** Traditional in-person learning is currently an A/B schedule. The schedule is subject to change at any given time in the semester. In-person learning may be five days a week, an A/B schedule, or full Distance Learning based on COVID protocols. The opt-out option is Putnam City School-at-Home.

Putnam City School-at-Home:

District teachers will facilitate Putnam City School-at-Home with district curriculum and will post lessons to SeeSaw or Google Classroom. Putnam City School-At-Home is a great option, but it is not the best option for all students. To be successful, a student must be independent, self-motivated, and may require significant home support. An adult may need to devote 2-3 hours per day to support their student's learning.

The learning path you choose is a semester long commitment from January 5, 2021 to May 27, 2021.

Please note: The State requires all students, even those enrolled in Putnam City School-at-Home, to take all state mandated assessments on-site at a student's home school.

If you are currently enrolled in Putnam City Virtual School, you will receive an e-mail with more information.

Estimados Padres y Tutores De la Escuela Primaria,

Con el segundo semestre acercándose, las familias tendrán la oportunidad de hacer cambios en la inscripción de sus estudiantes. Las opciones del segundo semestre cambiarán debido al personal requerido. **Su hijo se inscribirá automáticamente en el modelo de aprendizaje tradicional en persona a menos que usted opte por no participar en www.putnamcityschools.org/s2 antes del viernes 20 de noviembre de 2020.** El aprendizaje tradicional en persona es actualmente un horario A/B. El horario está sujeto a cambios en un momento dado en el semestre. El aprendizaje en persona puede ser de cinco días a la semana, un horario A/B o un aprendizaje a distancia completo basado en protocolos COVID. La opción de exclusión voluntaria es Putnam City School-at-Home (Putnam City en Casa).

Putnam City School-at-Home (Putnam City en Casa):

Los maestros del distrito facilitarán Putnam City School-at-Home con el plan de estudios del distrito y publicarán lecciones en SeeSaw o Google Classroom. Esta es una gran opción, pero no es la mejor opción para todos los estudiantes. Para tener éxito, un estudiante debe ser independiente, automotivado, y puede requerir un apoyo significativo en el hogar. Un adulto puede necesitar dedicar 2-3 horas al día para apoyar el aprendizaje de su estudiante.
