Dear families,

Putnam City Schools continues to closely monitor the evolving COVID situation and CDC guidance. With the rapidly increasing surge in positive cases in Oklahoma, the District is still requiring masks for all students and employees. As of January 3, 2022, the District is moving to the following:

If your child has tested positive for COVID-19:

If your child wears a mask:

- Stay home for a minimum of 5 days
- May return to school wearing a mask after the initial 5-day period if you're asymptomatic or your symptoms are improving

If your child has a mask opt out form on file:

- Stay home for a minimum of 5 days
- May return to school wearing a mask after the initial 5-day period if you're asymptomatic or your symptoms are improving
- If you are unable or unwilling to send your child with a mask for the second five-day period, your child will need to continue quarantining at home

If your child has been exposed to someone with COVID-19:

- If your child has received a booster OR completed their primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months (or 2 months after J&J) they should:
  - Continue coming to school and wearing a mask in accordance with the PC mask requirements
  - Test on day 5 from last date of exposure if possible
- If your child has not received a booster shot, completed their primary vaccine series, or is unvaccinated, they should:
  - Stay home for 5 days and can return to school wearing their mask after that period
  - If you are unwilling or unable to send your child with a mask for the second five-day period, your child will need to continue quarantining at home
  - Test on day 5 from last date of exposure if possible
- If your child develops symptoms, we recommend they get tested and stay home until you receive their results.
